

Fines and Fees:

Videocassettes/DVD

This collection includes feature films, documentaries and instructional films on both videocassette and DVD's. A part of our collection is referred to as the "New Hit" section, these films are popular, in demand titles that go out for 3 days for the first 3 months after they have arrived.

Loan Period/Fees:

- \$1.50+ tax/1 week or; \$3.00+ tax/2 weeks
- New Hit Films are \$2.50+ tax/3 days
- Fines: 25¢/day/title (\$10 maximum) Renewable/Reservable: Yes, except for New Hit Movies

Audio Books

The collection includes fiction and nonfiction titles in both the unabridged (complete) and abridged (condensed) versions on cassette, compact disc or the self-playing digital audio book, called Play Away's. Included are classic literature, recent bestsellers, history, business, health, etc.

Loan Period/Fees:

- 3 or more cassettes or 3 or more CDs in a box \$2.00+tax/3 weeks
- 1 or 2 cassettes or 1 or 2 CDs in a box no fee, 3 weeks
- Fines: 25¢/day/title (\$10 maximum) Renewable/Reservable: Yes

Video Games

This collection includes Sony Play station 2 & 3, PSP, Nintendo Wii, Nintendo DS, Nintendo 64, Game Cube, Xbox & Xbox 360.

Loan Period/Fees: 1 week, \$3.00+tax/title Fines: 25¢/day/title (\$20 maximum)
Renewable/Reservable: Yes

Music CD's

The CD collection includes rock, pop, jazz, rap, folk, R&B, classical, country, soundtracks & show tunes, world music, religious, new age and sound effects.

Loan Period/Fees: 3 weeks, no fee Fines: 25¢/day/title (\$10 maximum)
Renewable/Reservable: Yes

Oral History Tapes

The Library has a set of taped interviews with local residents recalling some of Chester County's local history. Copies of the tapes and their transcripts are available on request. These tapes and their transcripts are also available at the Chester County Historical Society.

Loan Period/Fees: 3 weeks, no fee Fines: 25¢/day/title (\$10 maximum)
Renewable/Reservable: Yes

Policies

- AV material may be returned to any public library in Chester County. An ACCESS borrower must return Chester County AV items to any Chester County library (even though books may be returned to their home library).
- AV staff will search and retrieve any phone request for up to 3 AV items that are on the shelf at the time and hold them for 1 day only.
- With the PA Access Label on your library card, you can borrow AV material at any public library in the state of Pennsylvania on your own, or the Library can try to access for you through Interlibrary Loan.
- AV equipment is not available for loan to the public.

Fee Waivers

Patrons that have a visual or physical handicap that prevents them from accessing our book collection can fill out the Chester County Library Visual/Physical Impairment Application to apply for no-fee audio book rentals. Patrons will be contacted by the Audio Visual department on whether they do or do not qualify for this service. Video rentals are not included in this service. However, patrons are responsible for FINES for overdue materials. Patrons are responsible for the cost and replacement of damaged items checked out on their library card. The Chester County Library assumes no responsibility for damage to patrons' equipment that is possibly caused by library materials.
