As you may have read in local newspapers, the Commissioners of the County of Chester have embarked on a Strategic Plan, making Chester County the first county in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to undertake a strategic planning project. The purpose of this project is to increase accountability, transparency and performance in Chester County government.

As a department of County government, the Chester County Library and its Henrietta Hankin Branch have participated in this process by developing a strategic business plan, which includes setting goals and performance criteria. In order to meet these goals, the Library has identified the activities which are most important to our customers and on which to focus our resources: providing library materials, information and reference services, quality library programs, and excellent customer relations. The Chester County Library, in its role as the District Center, must also provide services and support to the 16 partner libraries in the County.

During 2010, we will be collecting data with which to determine our baseline of outputs and efficiencies in order to set targets for future years. This will allow us to measure and evaluate our progress toward meeting our goals of providing the best possible materials and service to our customers.

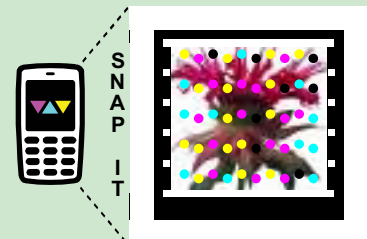


## GARDENING WITH NATIVE PLANTS FOR BIRDS & BUTTERFLIES

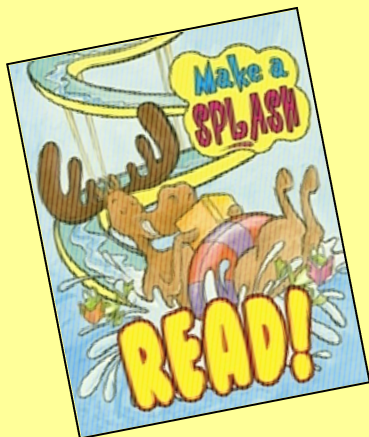

Participants can choose to earn prizes for reading or raise money for Clean Water for Haiti.

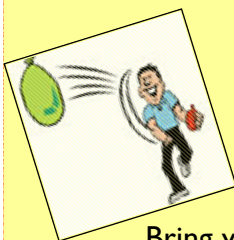
