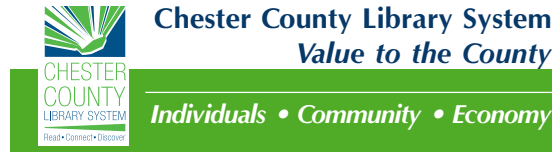
WHAT IS A LIBRARY ADVOCATE
