


NoveList

NoveList is a database that provides reviews, annotations and subject access to over 150,000 fiction books. Find in it author read-alikes, suggestions for books similar to your favorites, books in series, award winners, book discussion guides, feature articles and recommended reads. For teachers, there are curricular connections (such as Chinese Fiction for Young Adults), curriculum standards, grab & go book lists and picture book extenders.

Find It

Go to www.ccls.org>Databases (left green frame)>N>NoveList. If requested, enter your 14-digit Chester County Library System barcode number.

Get Help

Click **Help** (upper right corner) for how to's and hints. Click  for help on the current screen. On the Home Page, under **MyNoveList**, find Tour NoveList, My Folders and Alerts, and About NoveList. Readers' advisory means helping other people to find good books.

Browse It

- On the Home Page under **Browse**, click a **topic** under Adults, Teens, Older Kids, Younger Kids or Working with Kids.
- Click **Advanced Search**, under Browse, select Subject, Author, Series, Title or Dewey. Enter a search term in the **Browse For:** field or use the A to Z links to browse.

Search It

Simple Search

- Use the search box to find authors, titles, series, plot descriptions, articles and lists. **To find similar authors**, enter the name of a favorite author. Click Search. Click the Read-Alike tab. **To find similar books**, enter the title of a book. On the book's Web page, click Find Similar Books. **To find a book when you only remember a few details**, enter a character's name, place, time period or plot and select Describe a Plot. If there aren't enough results, try using fewer search terms.
- Use AND, OR or NOT. Use quotation marks around phrases.
- **To find books in a series**, type the series' name and click the button next to Series. Or type the title of a book in the series and click the button next to All. On the book's page, click the series' name.

Advanced Search

If you're looking for reviews, **check** the **box** next to **Review Available**. To see all searchable fields and their abbreviations, NoveList Best, the number of pages, words within reviews and more, **click Help>Field Codes**.

Display It

Click **Preferences** (upper right). Select the number of results per page to view. Choose to read Title only, Brief or Detailed results.

Save It

Save results as either permalinks or files. Put multiple articles in a folder to save, print or e-mail them just once. Items in the folder are deleted after the session.

The benefits of setting up an account (**My NoveList**) are to access your research remotely, save preferences, save articles for future sessions, save your search history beyond one session and create e-mail alerts and RSS feeds.

Take It

Click **Print** and choose formats. **Clicking** the **Quick Print** icon prints a list of books with essential information, compactly spaced.

From the full record, **click E-Mail**, enter the e-mail address and **click Send**.

Cite It

Click **Help** in the upper right hand corner. In the menu on the left, **click one** of the **citation styles** listed (*AMA, APA, Chicago, MLS, Vancouver*). Read the guidelines provided.
