

Downloading eBooks to the OverDrive App on the iPad, iPod and iPhone

The OverDrive app was created for the iPhone, but is compatible with the iPad. The OverDrive app requires a newer version of Apple's mobile operating system, iOS 4.0 or newer. Currently, iOS 4.2 is available for free through your iTunes account on your computer (make sure you have the most recent version of iTunes). Just connect your device to your computer to download the update.

1. Log into the App Store and search "OverDrive Media Console."
2. Install app.
3. Open app once it is installed.
4. You will need an Adobe ID to download in the OverDrive Media Console. To input your Adobe ID and password:
 - Select "Get Books."
 - In the bottom menu, select "Settings."
 - Select "Authorize with Adobe ID."
 - Enter your Adobe ID and password if you already have one.
 - If you do not have an Adobe ID, select "Get Adobe ID." You will be directed to the Internet. Follow the instructions to create an Adobe ID.
5. Once you have logged in with your Adobe ID, select "Get Books."
6. Select "Add a Website."
7. Under "Find a Library," type "Chester County Library" and select "Chester County Library System" or your local library from the list of options. Select "Available Formats" and you will be directed to OverDrive's eMedia catalog where you can search for eBooks and eAudiobooks.
8. Search the catalog to find an item you wish to download. If it is available for checkout, "Add to eBookBag" will be seen in the catalog entry. If an item you want is not available, you can place a hold on that item. Once the item is in your eBookBag, select "Proceed to Checkout" to start the download process.
9. Type your library card number and select "Sign In."
10. You will be directed to your eBookBag. You may be able to choose your lending period (usually 7 or 14 days). Select "Confirm Check Out," then select "Download."
11. Your title will start downloading in the OverDrive media console.
12. Once the title has downloaded to your OverDrive media console, it will be available in the "Library" for the lending period designated to that item. Click on the title to begin reading or listening to your book.
