

OXFORD MUSIC ONLINE



Oxford Music Online (OMO) is a database of classical, opera, jazz, rock, pop, country, folk, rap, reggae, techno, musicals and world music. Read about popular music genres, trends, styles, record labels, venues and music festivals. Find lists of works, short audio files, illustrations and timelines. Its content is from the redesigned *Grove Music Online* (continuously revised), the *Encyclopedia of Popular Music*, the *Oxford Companion to Music* and the *Oxford Dictionary of Music*. Content from the latter three sources is not regularly revised.

There is a **Guided Tour** under **Find Out More on the Homepage**. For abbreviations, topical guides, timelines of music and research guides **click Tools and Resources**.

If you are timed out, log in again.

Find It

Remote access – go to our website, www.ccls.org, **click the Access PA Power Library icon**. Type your library card barcode number. Under **Art/Music**, **click Oxford Music Online**.

Library access – same instructions as above, however, there's no need to enter your library barcode number.

Browse It

- All content, Biographies or Subject Entries
- alphabetically or jump directly to a word or phrase
- browse content from a specific source

Search It

Quick Searches search the full-text of *OMO*

- Enter your search terms in lower-case letters, unless you want your search to take case into account.
- Limit your search to the sources you check on the left.
- **Click** the **[+]** to view topical subcategories (e.g. People in history, Classical antiquity, Places). Select one or more of these to further refine your search.
- Use AND, OR, NOT, and NEAR to define the relationship between your search terms.
- Use ? to replace a single letter you aren't sure of.
- Use * in place of one or more letters.
- Use Advanced Search to search works for label, biographical details, publications, discographies, compilations, year of release or videography.
- Use parentheses or brackets to do a nested search. e.g. (sea OR ocean) AND land
- Control whether the results must match all search terms or any of the search terms.

Tabs

Relevant Search tips are on each tabbed page.

• **Main Search**

Add or delete a source. Refine by searching Full Article Text, Entry Title, Bibliographies, Contributors or Works lists.

• **Biography Search**

Search by Name, Occupation, Nationality or Country of Activity, Year of Birth or Death, Place of Birth or Death.

• **Bibliography Search**

Search by Author or Editor name, Book or Journal Title, Year of Publication, or Chapter or Article Title.

Results

- Optional highlighting of search terms
- **Click Results per Page** to control the number of results per page, up to 100.
- Most relevant results displayed first
- Filter results by Source Title, Topic or Type of Content, such as Biographies.
- Co-authors appear as Jane Smith and John Doe.
- An author and an editor appear as Jane Smith/Robert Brown.
- Go to a section of an article by **clicking it** in the **Table of Contents** to the left of the article. Expand and collapse the section headings by **clicking** the **+** or **- signs**.

Bibliographies

Search within bibliographies for Authors or Editors, Book or Journal Titles, Years of Publication, Chapter or Article Titles. Often scholarly with many sub-categories, e.g. Catalogue of Works, Collections of Essays, Studies of the Works, Catalogue and Description of the Archives, etc.

Take It

Click Print. The article will open in a printer-friendly format. **Click Email** to send a link to the article to anyone with an e-mail address. The link will connect for two weeks.

Cite It

MLA and Chicago formats are supported. Either cut and paste the citations into your paper or export them to EndNote, ProCite, ReferenceManager or RefWorks.

End It

Log out when finished.
