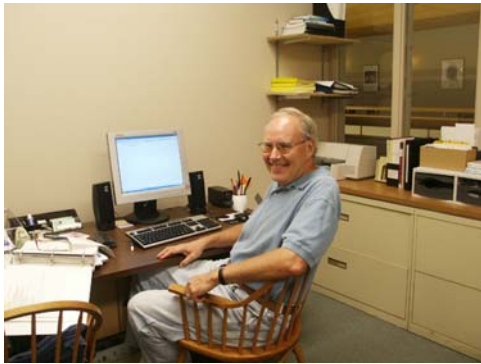

We have a schedule to fit your busy schedule. Volunteer opportunities are available during the morning, afternoon and evening hours, weekdays or weekends. Chester County Library volunteers can choose from a variety of activities that are essential to the library. No previous library experience is necessary. Training will be provided.

WHAT INTERESTS YOU?

Volunteers are often needed in the following areas. Below is a sampling.

Audio Visual Collection Care

Assists in reshelving of audio visual materials and answers directional questions for patrons.

Adopt-A-Shelf (Exton Only)

Responsible for maintaining the order of materials in a selected area of the Library. A sign denoting that a volunteer has adopted-a-shelf will be placed near the volunteer's adopted area.

Collection Care

Assists with shelving books and other library materials and helps locate books for patron holds.

Public Computer Center

Assists patrons in the use of PCs. Depending on skills, may also assist in computer workshops. Volunteers must have broad computer skills and knowledge.

As with any public venue, our volunteers must be ready and able to interact with the public in a professional and courteous manner. Successful completion of the placement test (putting decimal numbers and author's names in order), and an ability to read labels on top and bottom shelves is required in the Adopt-A-Shelf and Collection Care areas. General commitment is 3 hours, one day per week. Note that those volunteering in Youth Services are subject to a background check per Pennsylvania state law.

Other Volunteer Opportunities

- During the Library's Summer Reading Program (6 week program).
- In the Library's Reader for the Visually Impaired program (volunteers read excerpts from the *Daily Local News* onto cassette tape).
- In various departments throughout the Library.
- As a member for the Friends of the Chester County Library.
